Dear Air Marshal DA La Fontaine,

Kindly refer to your letter no. CAC/2308/16/ED dated 27th 1eb 84 regarding setting up of a residential Public School at Gwalior for the Children of Air Force Personnel.

- I have had the matter looked into. According to the Callester Gwalior the Station Officer Commanding, Air Force, Gwalior has also requested for the establishment of a school at village Girgaon aside the Gwalior-Bhind state High-way, Khasra No. 61, 64,65& 66, Comprising an area of 15 acres of land, which is vacant. As the land in question is situated outside greater Gwalior, it will be available at lesser rates. However, according to the Nazul rules, this land has to be transferred to the Government of India. Under the provisions of clause 23 of RBC IV-1 and para (3) of RBC I-7, the cost of the land has been estimated at & 17,1 .686.68 (Prentum Rs 5,96,739.18 Plas capital value of Rs 11,18.947.50).
- The State Government egree to the transfer of the aforesaid 15 acres of land to the Indian Mir Force and also to bar 50% of the cost of construction, spread over a period of three years, c convencing from the financial year 1984-85. As the total cost of the construction of the public school is estimated to be Rs 75 les the state's share of 50% would be Rs 37.50 lacs for the reciod in question.
- The state Government would be happy to share the financial burden as above, subject to the condition that 50% of the seats is earmarked for the children of the citizens of this state.
- I earnestly hope that you would kindly agree to the above conditions. I lobk forward to a reply from yo .
